Powder coat

Characteristics:

Powder coat is a hard, colourfast finishing layer. A powder coated frame or component is durable and easy to maintain. Powder coating can be applied in a wide variety of colours and textures.

Lacquer

Characteristics:

Wet varnish coating is a colour finish available in virtually any desired colour, gloss and texture. This furniture finish, which does not react to chemical agents, meets the highest quality standards.

Maintenance and cleaning:

It is best to clean surfaces that this wet varnish coating have been applied to, with lukewarm water with the optional addition of a mild, non-abrasive soap. We recommend you avoid firmly buffing a single spot, as this could create a polished effect that could cause differences in the gloss you see across the surfaces. We also advise against using abrasive agents and scourers, as these will scratch the surface.

Stain

Characteristics:

Most of our wooden arm layers, backs and seats have a stain finish. The wooden structure is clearly visible through the transparent stain layer. The under laying has a great influence at the ultimate image. The under laying of the samples is beech (like most arm layers and seating units).

Maintenance and cleaning:

The most effective method of cleaning stained surfaces is to use water and a soft, not-abrasive fluid soap. Furniture polishes and wax are discouraged, as they can cause a buildup of wax and silicone. This can lead to discolouration and streaks, making it impossible to touch up any damage.

Laminate

Characteristics:

Laminate is a hard, plastic top layer glued to the base material. This creates a scratch-resistant table top.

Maintenance and cleaning:

The most effective method of cleaning laminate surfaces is to use warm water and a soft, not-abrasive detergent. After cleaning, thoroughly remove any soap residue and wipe dry with a soft cloth to prevent smears. Under no circumstances should scouring pads or harsh abrasive cleaners be used. For persistent stains in structured surfaces, use a soft brush. Prolonged contact with aggressive detergents can cause permanent stains.

Veneer

Characteristics:

Veneer is a natural product that gives your table or cabinet a warm and natural appearance. Veneer shares all the characteristics of wood. Depending on the type of wood, the top layer can be harder or softer. Even within the same type of wood, variations in grain pattern and colour may occur. Lande recommends specifying during your order that the top layers of different products should come from the same veneer log. Additional orders may show variations in colour and pattern. Veneer can discolor when exposed to sunlight.

Maintenance and cleaning:

Lacquered surfaces are best cleaned with water and, if necessary, a mild, non-abrasive liquid soap.

Oil

Characteristics:

Oak or veneer components are sometimes treated with oil to achieve various finishes while retaining the visible texture of the oak base material. The oil used by Lande (Rubio Monocoat) forms a molecular bond with the base material, ensuring excellent durability and wear resistance.

Maintenance and cleaning:

Wipe regularly with an almost dry cloth: this is sufficient. If necessary, you can use the 'Monocoat Maintenance Kit for Furniture', available at www.monocoatwebshop.nl.
